

Case Presentation

- Lovely 70F presented with new-onset of abdominal swelling, early satiety, and constipation.
- She presented to her PCP who ordered a CA-125 (1500) and a CT scan which revealed bilateral ovarian masses, ascites, and peritoneal disease along the abdominal wall.
- She was referred to a gynecologic oncologist and underwent cytoreductive surgery (2 cm residual disease), and was diagnosed with stage IIIC high grade papillary serous carcinoma.
- After surgery her CA-125 was 1000.
- After 2 cycles of carboplatinum and taxol her CA-125 was 600.
- After 6 cycles it was 70.
- After 8 cycles her CA-125 dropped to 20.
- Five months later her CA-125 was 40. Restaging scans showed new stranding in the mesentery and a 1.8x1.0 cm node near porta hepatis....
